

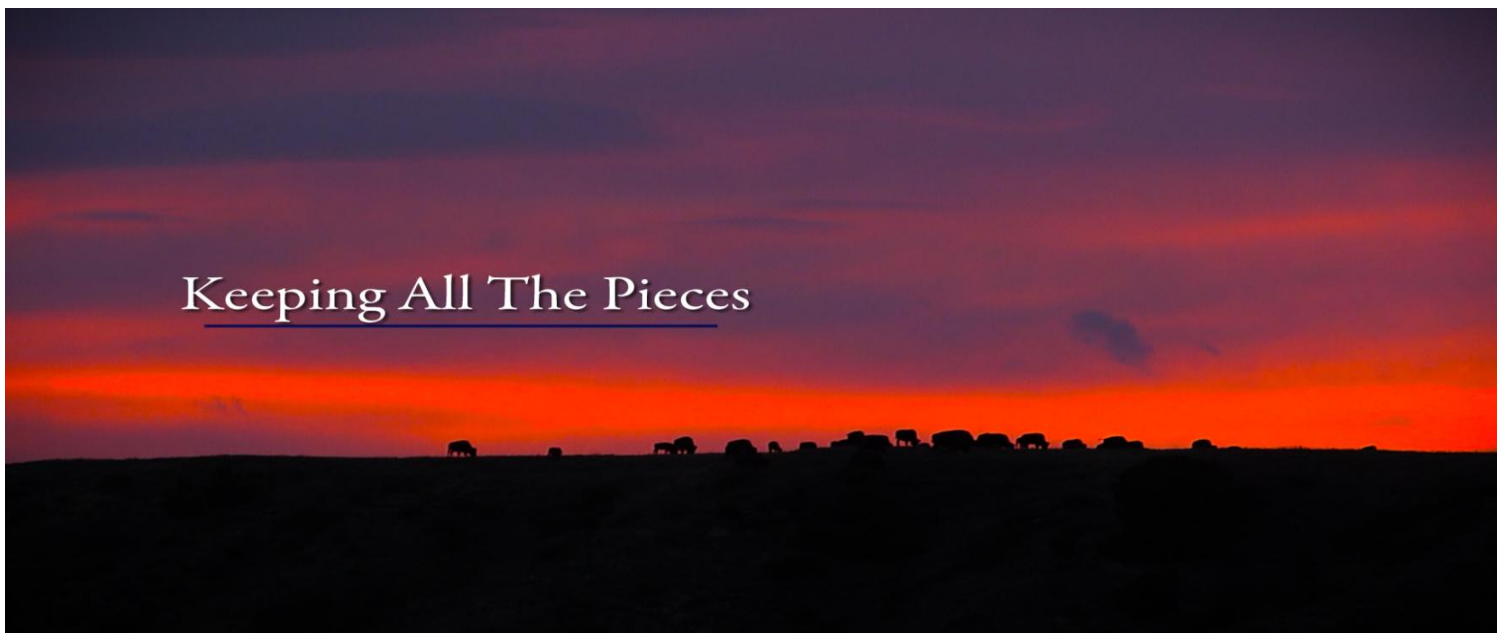
Lewis and Clark Wildlife Club
